Experience in bridge/project inspection preferred but not required. Candidate will be trained in all aspects of the position.

Performs bridge inspections and assists in managing the bridge inspection process for the department. Provides inspection assistance and support under the direction of the County Engineer. Conducts inspections of construction projects and existing infrastructure on the county highway system.

Assists County Engineer with bridge inspection activities. Inspects bridge structures for defects and coordinates repairs as needed. Fills out required inspection forms for state submittal. Manages bridge inspection activities for the department.

Acts as inspector for various federal, state and locally funded road and bridge projects. Inspects ODOT LPA projects, including road and bridge projects programmed through the state DOT. Completes daily project diaries and ensures compliance with ODOT's construction and material specifications. Maintains project files and documentation as required by ODOT and federal standards.

Assists with and inspects construction projects in progress to assess compliance with plans and quality standards, including work performed under utility and right-of-way permits, and new subdivision roads. Conducts inspections of the county roads, bridges and culverts to assess condition and rating. Completes required paperwork and reports as required.

Prefer knowledge of engineering methods and equipment, computer software, programs, and applications.

Ability to apply engineering principles to practical situations; follow technical instructions; read and interpret construction plans.
