The appropriate and highly desired candidates shall demonstrate a high degree of mission adherence. The **Intervention Caseworker** shall provide intervention services to families, prepare and file complaints, motions, and other court material, testify in court hearings, complete all written contacts, dictations, SAR's, case plans, and other materials, collaborate with and act as a liaison with court, mental health, medical professionals, local authorities, etc. The **Assessment Caseworker** shall provide intake and assessment services involving allegations of neglect, physical, emotional, and sexual abuse; complete all family assessment reports; prepare and file complaints, motions, and other court material in a timely manner; testify in court hearings, when needed, write suspected crime reports and work with local authorities, etc.

The desired candidates must be willing to perform after-hours duty, related Adult and Child Welfare activities and other duties as assigned.

Requirements: Must have a Bachelor's Degree in a related field, and a valid driver's license.
