

## **Muskingum Soil and Water Conservation District 2025 Summer Forestry Internship Available**

The Forestry Internship opportunity is funded through the Muskingum Soil and Water Conservation District (MSWCD) and the Muskingum County Auditor's office and is a paid part-time position, lasting 10-12 weeks (total number of hours yet to be determined). This intern will assist our Forestry/Wildlife Specialist with forestry inspections and plans. To be eligible, students must be high school graduates and in college majoring in forestry or an environmental or conservation science field. Must be able to pass a criminal background check and a driving record check and be insured to drive a District vehicle. All Internship positions are flexible as to what days/hours must be worked, as long as the required hours are obtained within 12 weeks. To be considered for the internship, the application, resume and essay must be submitted by March 15, 2025. Essay must address why the applicant is interested in the internship, what strengths the applicant would bring to the internship, and future career plans. Applicants will be contacted for phone interviews by the end of March.
