QUALIFICATIONS: Previous mechanic experience preferred
Ability to pass all pre-employment screenings, including background and drug screen.

Performs general maintenance, repair and reconditioning of trucks and light and heavy motorized highway equipment. Performs routine preventative maintenance on trucks and equipment. Diagnoses mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic malfunctions and performs or directs repairs as needed. Assists in computer-based troubleshooting and diagnosis of vehicle and equipment repair.

ASE or equivalent training in Cummins Insite, Diamond Logic, Allison Transmission, Service Max, and Master Diagnostics. Ability to read electrical and hydraulic schematics.

Performs maintenance, repair and reconditioning of automobiles, pick-up trucks, single axle and tandem axle dump trucks, tractor truck and dump trailer, low-boy carry all, tractors, mowers, bulldozers, crawler and rubber-tire hydraulic excavators, front end loaders, loader backhoes, snowplows, compressors, graders, pumps, concrete mixers, motors, and other mechanical parts and equipment including hydraulic components.

Performs routine preventive maintenance of road equipment. Checks tire air pressure and tightens lug-nuts. Changes oil and replaces filters, lubricates grease fittings, changes sparkplugs, checks and fills radiators, transmission fluids and other reservoirs, as well as other needed preventative maintenance items.

Diagnoses mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic malfunctions; performs mechanical and repair tasks as needed.

Performs acetylene or electric welding and blacksmithing in forming, bending, and tempering iron and steel.

Road tests vehicles and equipment following repair process to ensure proper operating condition.

Completes work records and maintains computer files related to vehicle and equipment repairs and preventative maintenance.

Performs mechanical repairs off site along roadway and other locations throughout the county. Will work in all weather conditions including snow and ice while performing repairs on county vehicles and equipment.
