

## Summer Forestry Internship Available

The Muskingum Soil and Water Conservation District (MSWCD) is hiring a summer intern to assist our Forestry/Wildlife Specialist with inspecting Forestry Current Agricultural Use Valuation (CAUV) Plans.

Skills and abilities needed: basic forestry skills such as native tree identification, ability to work outside, and independently. Applicants must possess good communication skills to work with all types of landowners. Applicants should be familiar with common forestry practices, managing forests for wildlife, invasive species identification, and control methods for invasive species.

The Intern will assist the MSWCD Forestry/Wildlife Specialist with performing CAUV site visits in the form of inspections, once trained.

Applicants must be able to successfully pass a drug screening, background check, driving check, and must be insurable. This is a field position, so applicants must be willing and able to work in all weather conditions as well as types of terrain.

This internship is 160 hours total, to be worked up to 29 hours per week beginning in May/June and ending in August 2026. The rate of pay is \$16.00 per hour. The schedule is flexible, but hours must be worked between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday-Friday.
