- 1. Zanesville-Muskingum County Health Department**
Wages for COVID-19 contact tracers and medical staff
Funding Amount: \$100,000.00
- 2. Southern-Sundale Waterline Extension**
Drinking waterline extension in Union Township, providing water access to 175 households.
Funding Amount: \$1,723,455.75
- 3. Big B-Mutton Ridge Waterline Extension**
Drinking waterline extension in Washington/Madison Township, providing water access to 55 households
Funding Amount: \$358,300.47
- 4. Twin Hills Drive Waterline Extension**
Drinking waterline extension in Falls Township, providing water access to 35 households.
Funding Amount: \$368,243.78
- 5. Genesis Healthcare System**
Purchase of two GE CareScape 860 Ventilators for treatment of COVID-19 patients.
Funding Amount: \$88,233.21
- 6. Muskingum County Engineers Office**
Replacement of lost gas tax revenue in 2020 (\$442,547.00) and the purchase of estimated annual culvert pipe needed for replacement & repairs (\$151,300.00).
Funding Amount: \$593,847.00
- 7. Honor Flight**
Sponsorship of two Muskingum County Veterans on the Honor Flight to Washington DC.
Funding Amount: \$1,000.00
- 8. Heroes Landing Children's Justice Center**
Located in Muskingum County, the Center provides medical and forensic evaluation to victims locally, rather than outsourced to a regional facility, for more effect service.
Funding Amount: \$500,000.00
- 9. Genesis Retention Bonus**
Incentive program available to 1,263 employees at Genesis Healthcare System that awards a wage bonus in return for an employment commitment of two years.
Funding Amount: \$2,300,000.00

10. 2200 Linden Ave Surface Cleanup (Lear)

Removal of surface blight on the property, situated along the well-traveled Linden Avenue in Zanesville.

Funding Amount: \$500,000.00

11. Munson Scope Evaluation

Professional evaluation to determine cost associated with potential rehabbing of Munson School into housing; deemed not fiscally feasible.

Funding Amount: \$9,000.12

12. Waterline (Installation)-Muskingum County Fairgrounds

Installation cost of a new water supply line to the Clean Face restroom facility.

Funding Amount: \$50,223.00

13. Waterline (Materials) -Muskingum County Fairgrounds

Material cost for the water supply line for the Clean Face restroom facility.

Funding Amount: \$19,536.95

14. Waterline Extension (Plumbing)-Muskingum County Fairgrounds

Interior plumbing repairs to the Clean Face restroom facility prior to the 2022 fair.

Funding Amount: \$2,270.52

15. Mid-East CDL Training & Testing Center

Aid to the program development at the Church Hill Road facility in Muskingum County, operated by Mid-East Career and Technology Center. This training and testing center will create a stronger workforce locally and meet the high demand for CDL requirements.

Funding Amount: \$300,000.00

16. Hydrant Work-Muskingum County Fairgrounds

Frost Free Hydrant Installation on water lines around the livestock barns at the Muskingum County Fairgrounds.

Funding Amount: \$7,846.37

17. Muskingum County Center For Seniors

Fleet upgrades for homebound meal deliveries and shelf stable meals for deliveries.

Funding Amount: \$100,000.00

18. Grandstand Bleacher Installation

Aid for a portion of the new bleacher project in the grandstand at the Muskingum County Fairgrounds.

Funding Amount: \$20,446.47

19. MARCS Radio Upgrade for Township & Village Fire Departments

Funding up to 80% of cost for township and village MARC radio upgrades, a requirement to ensure emergency communication across all channels.

Funding Amount: \$56,700.00

20. Arch Hill-Norfield Rd Waterline Extension

Drinking waterline extension in Salem and Perry Townships, providing water access to approximately 60 homes. This project is currently in the planning phase.

Funding Amount: \$400,000.00

21. Virginia Ridge-Irish Ridge Rd Waterline Extension

Drinking waterline extension in Brush Creek and Harrison Townships, providing water access to approximately 200 households. This project is currently in the planning phase.

Funding Amount: \$400,000.00

22. Genesis Retention Bonus (Final Round)

Incentive program available to 1,263 employees at Genesis Healthcare System that awards a wage bonus in return for an employment commitment of two years.

Funding Amount: \$2,481,000.00

23. MCCFA-Gateway District Project

Pledge to MCCFA to aid in the Gateway District Project in Downtown Zanesville. This project is in the planning phase.
