BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Muskingum County, Ohio, that pursuant to R.C. 5538.08(A), the sum of \$12,500.00 (twelve thousand five hundred & 00/100 dollars) shall be distributed from the County General fund to each of the townships located within Muskingum County to be used solely for the purpose of the repair and maintenance of the roads under the control of the individual townships.
