- Commissioner Crooks reported that Mayor Mason asked them to just manage the Lorena, with no intention of selling it to them
- Commissioner Cameron suggested that Valley Gem come to session to talk to all the Commissioners

Commissioner Cameron asked if the Clerk could start scheduling Employee Evaluation meetings.
