- Matt reported that resurfacing costs are up 50% from 2021
- All design work is being done in-house; otherwise they could not afford as many bridge projects
- They will only be purchasing four new trucks this year because the cost has increased by 25%
 - o Commissioner Cameron said it is her feeling that it is totally unacceptable for County employees to be driving vehicles in that shape
- Muskingum County is number one in the State with 527 miles
 - o Number ten for 405 bridges
- There was discussion regarding the License Fees
 - o Commissioner Cameron said that the greatest complaint from citizens is the condition of the roads
 - Ohio Revised Code provides for (3) \$5 increments to add to vehicle license fees by the following means;
 - Emergency; requires unanimous vote by Commissioners
 - Hold public hearings; unanimous vote not needed
 - Place on election ballot
 - Must be certified before July 1
- There was discussion regarding a new administrative building for the Engineer
 - o He reported that they currently have ongoing water damage
 - o They continually have rodents of all sorts living in and under the current facility
 - o Last year they had an electrical fire, but it was extinguished by the water leak
 - Mark is working on plans for the building, but up to the Commissioners regarding funding
