The Commissioners clarified several items of misinformation regarding the possible jail.

- It will not be a regional jail
- There is no final decision
- The County Jail Committee must approve before any decisions are made
- The area would be remediated to 2 feet below grade

These residents would like to be more involved in the process. Perhaps a survey of the surrounding residents. The Commissioners explained that there are not enough facts for a public meeting at this time.

The Sheriff explained the need for a new jail and offered to take them on a tour of the current facility that was built in 1975 for 40 inmates and now houses, some days, more that 200 inmates. The residents said they are not opposed to a new jail, but are opposed to locating it on the Mosaic Tile property, in their neighborhood. None of the guests chose to go on a tour of the current jail.

Sheriff Lutz stayed after the meeting to discuss the property at 1308 Coopermill Road. The current "squatters" have broken off the sewer cap. Stan Lucas, Sewer Department has filed a report of vandalism and theft of services. A deputy was called to the site and a complaint was filed.
