  - o And his earlier comment, before we even knew who had applied, about picking someone based on what they can do, not just someone's friend
    - Would be hard pressed to find five people to interview that someone here doesn't know
- Commissioner Crooks underscored this is an important position
  - Commissioner Cameron thinks the communication part of this position is really important
- Commissioner Crooks noted that the characteristics and strengths that she was looking for were not something that you could find on paper, needed to observe in person; she was pleasantly surprised by the caliber of people interested in the position
