The difficulty of getting to the scene of a wreck was discussed and seems it will be very difficult. There is also the question of who will pay for the extra cost of Emergency Personnel and wrecker crews getting to the scene. This needs to be discussed with ODOT.

Carmen Boyd and Amy Pennington came to meet with the Commissioners for Childhood Cancer Awareness Month. The Commissioners presented them with a proclamation and will light the Courthouse gold.

Commissioner Cameron reported that she talked with Wendy Sowers, Clerk of Courts, who had talked with the Common Pleas Judge and he will not allow purses in the Courtroom. New lockers have been purchased for the Security entrance of the Courthouse to store purses and personal items not allowed in the Courtroom. The Clerk informed the Commissioners that Leah Vensil, who has been retained to help utilize the Opioid Settlement monies in the Zanesville Middle School Gym classes, has asked if we could order her Botvin materials. The Commissioners agreed.

The Commissioners talked with Reagan, at the Adoption Center, as Amanda was out, regarding the July invoice from the Animal Shelter.

- She explained that the Adoption Center cannot do rabies vaccines or heartworm tests; must be a veterinarian or vet tech
 - So they used the Animal Shelter to administer, along with some spay/neuters
 - o It's her understanding they will not be using the Animal Shelter in the future
