- Clean Face
 - o Eric distributed a Proposed Scope provided by APG
 - Nearly \$306,000
- Remove EMA Pole Barn request from list
- Avondale
 - o Only HVAC figured into ARPA at this time
- Genesis
 - o Eric understood that the \$2.3 was the commitment now and left the balance in the "Pending" column for consideration later
 - o Not sure what Genesis' understanding is
- Munson
 - Commissioner Crooks understanding that it will be first part of January before Scope is completed
- Lear property
 - o County gave \$500,000
 - o Award bid was \$732,000

Commissioner Crooks would like to look at the projects and determine those that would be done even if we hadn't received ARPA dollars.

There was continued discussion regarding the Clean Face project.

- Eric has talked with Jason Baughman, Chief Building Official, regarding this project
- Waterline should be completed before the restroom renovations begin
- Denis Swierz will do the utility survey in January
 - Once that is completed, Mark Eicher will do the design
 - Mark expects that to be done by April
- Commissioner Crooks reported that she and Don Madden attended the Fair Board meeting Tuesday
 - o She presented both waterline plans to them
 - A. What the Fair Board had approved at their October meeting
 - B. What the Commissioners had proposed
 - It was unanimous that they want to go with Plan A; the original design they had approved in October
 - Commissioner Porter's opinion would be that if we're paying for it, we should at least do what we think is best
 - Commissioner Crooks said she presented that it is the Commissioners' goal to remedy the water issue at Clean Face
 - o Don said that it will not be more pressure, but more volume of water
 - O Commissioner Porter does not understand the rationale....if you've got the chance to replace all those waterlines that blows apart all the time...
 - O At the 12/14/2021 Fair Board Meeting, Fair Board members said they have not had any issues

The Commissioners met virtually with ODOT for update on the IR70 reconstruction.

There was discussion regarding the pay request from Flecto for the Adoption Center.

• It was decided to hold payment of the request

There was some follow-up discussion regarding Clean Face

• Commissioner Porter said he is not sure how he will vote
